What were the biggest hurdles you overcame on the way to Presidential Diamond?

Throughout this process, I have experienced "mom guilt" when I was working a lot and missed moments in my children's lives. When I started this business, I was motivated primarily by the desire to create the financial means to give my special needs son the medical and educational attention that would maximize his growth and abilities. When I did miss something

in my kids' lives, I just told myself that I was doing this for a relatively short period of time so that in the future I could be completely present for my children. I remained hyper focused on getting my business up as fast as possible. I did a lot of things beyond my comfort level, like speaking in front of a crowd, asking numerous health practitioners and spa owners for a place to hold classes, and traveling long distances from my home. I even slept in my car one night while traveling







for classes! But my Why—helping my child—is the greatest motivation a parent could have.

I also built my business while dealing with my own significant health challenges—issues that were nearly debilitating. At times, I had to take time out to get medical attention, but I was determined to find a way to get better. In the meantime, when I went back to places where I had enrolled people and heard how the oils had so blessed their lives, I felt compelled to continue building so others would find similar help. It was so motivating to me to see how the oils and the business could profoundly change people's lives for the better.

What advice would you give to someone who is trying to reach Presidential Diamond?

First, have a good support system, especially for those times when you feel like quitting. My sisters and my mom are on my front line. They have backed me up, talked me down, and cheered me on through the good and the bad times. Second, take consistent action. Teach classes and enroll new people. While doing that, keep track of your business. Know how many people you and your leaders and builders are enrolling. If things are not growing, try something different. Reach out to leaders in other organizations for ideas and collaboration as well. Set small attainable goals and celebrate those small wins. Additionally, and very importantly, work with the sharers in your organization. I know a Blue Diamond who built her whole organization on sharers. Help your sharers; I have seen many sharers turn into builders with help and encouragement from their upline. Finally, never give up. Focus on what this business gives you. The freedom to do what you want, when you want, how you want, and helping those you want is one of the greatest gifts this rank will provide.

While it is true that reaching the rank of Presidential Diamond is going to involve work and stress, I have found that being Presidential is easier than any other rank because of the resources and the leaders available to help you. I don't think anyone really avoids stress or work by not going for Presidential. This rank can give you the freedom to create a life you have only dreamed about. Moreover, if you are driven by helping others, remember that you can help and influence more people at this level.

At this stage, what motivates you to continue building your business?

The reason I went from Blue to Presidential was to better help other families with special needs, children in the developing world, and most of all, single mothers of special needs children. It is extremely hard to be a special needs parent and even more so when a partner leaves upon finding out their child isn't typical. I wish I could say this was not so prevalent, but unfortunately, it is.

How has this business changed your life?

Our dōTERRA business made it possible for our son, who has many health issues, to get the treatments and attention that he needs. It's made it possible for us to help many more families in the same spot we have been in. I really love to help others and am all about living a life that most people only dream of. We live in San Diego with amazing views of the ocean. We go surfing and are able to have a private teacher for our son who needed to be home schooled. Every 6-12 months I create a dream board. This last time I updated my dream board I put up a picture of an oil supply store and decided to open an oil tool store that gives back to charity to help sick kids.


With her perspective and clear goals, Jeanese was able to truthfully share her commitment to her doTERRA business with her team at her salon





"I believe in a big God with a big purpose for my life."


and positivity," shares Yolanda. "In many ways this optimistic mindset comes naturally to me. 

ustralian founder Robyn Simon, age 74, is a living archive of dōTERRA® history down under. As a builder in the early days, Robyn faced remarkable hurdles in getting her own dōTERRA business off the ground, but also mentoring generations of leaders who would follow in her footsteps. Her sphere of influence has grown from an essential oil online forum, to a sprawling network of international Wellness Advocates that have been touched by her mentorship, knowledge, and love.

From the begining, Robyn was in the trenches, cheerfully greasing all the gears that powered dōTERRA's growth in Australia. From shuttling visiting executives to and from the airport, to fastidious record keeping, she managed the details, no matter how small. This was especially true when Robyn's team suffered the loss of upline leaders. In those days, with their structure in peril, Robyn was desperate

to aid in the search for replacements. She found what she was looking for in John Overbeek and Paula Eckert. She remembers, "When I saw them meeting and greeting people at a local town meeting, handing out dōTERRA sample oil bottles and lanyards, I was impressed." It was not long after that John and Paula flew up to Sydney, where Robyn's team gathered to accept John and Paul as their new upline.

Robyn and her growing team continued to face logistical and leadership challenges as their presence grew in Australia. Yet, despite the hills and valleys of being an early builder, Robyn's vision has always centered on building relationships. Her love of people and her passion for the product gave her an anchoring purpose. She explains, "Amidst all the challenges of the early days, there were always bright moments that sustained me and others."

One such bright moment took place while Robyn was in Utah for a Diamond Day training with Alyse Sedviy. Kirk Hamilton and his wife Jennifer generously offered to host Robyn during her stay. In the course of conversation, Kirk reminisced about his own early days building his doTERRA business and the story about placing John and Paula came full circle. "Kirk told me, 'Robyn, when your team placed John and Paula as your new upline, it impacted me and my family thousands of miles away. Jennifer and I were just starting out and struggling financially. Then out of nowhere, there was about \$800 added to our family paycheck. It was a miracle."

There, with the Hamilitons, Robyn saw clearly the ripples of her consistent efforts, year after year. "What we are doing in our business, in our teams, and in the lives of those we touch is far bigger than we could ever imagine," she says.
