




Cō-Impact Sourcing®: 2024 Focus Area

1 Building Supplier Capacity

Through the Cō-Impact Sourcing[®] Challenge Fund, dōTERRA collaborated with sourcing partners to implement innovative solutions that elevate sourcing practices, enhance worker wellbeing, and promote sustainability.

To date, **\$207,000** from the Challenge Fund has been invested in **21** supplier projects.

In 2024, these funds enabled significant progress through projects such as:

2 Fostering Environmental Stewardship

By promoting energy efficiency, renewable energy, and waste valorization, we support practices that minimize environmental impact, conserve resources, and uplift producers in the regions where we source essential oils. These efforts extend across our supply chain, reinforcing our commitment to sustainable practices.

Here's how these efforts are shaping a more sustainable future:

Circular Economy in Birch Essential Oil Production

At dōTERRA Woodside Oils, we turn waste into opportunity by repurposing birch bark and pole wood, promoting a circular economy that benefits the environment and local communities while reducing waste and supporting pure Birch essential oil production. In 2024, this commitment resulted in the following impact:

- 1,055,120 pounds of birch bark repurposed from waste streams
- 1,492,600 pounds of birch pole wood processed into essential oil within a 50-mile radius
- Near-zero waste, distributing all spent birch material as mulch to local communities and events, including Kare for Kane, an annual borough beautification event in Kane, PA

2 Fostering Environmental Stewardship

Kenya Climate Adaptation Program

In Kenya's Lunga Lunga region, small-scale farmers producing Tea Tree and Lemon Eucalyptus essential oils, face increasing climate challenges. Unpredictable rainfall, droughts, and extreme weather threaten productivity. To mitigate these risks, we've co-funded a multiyear initiative to strengthen crop resilience for over 1,000 farmers, which included:

- \$270,000 in sustainable water management investments
- New dam liners and drip irrigation kits capture rainwater, support irrigation during dry periods, reduce reliance on erratic rainfall, and deliver water directly to crops, minimizing evaporation and runoff
- Foot pumps enable farmers to more easily irrigate their crops without having to rely on electricity or fuel

Technology-Driven Water Conservation in Italy

In partnership with our Bergamot essential oil sourcing partner in Italy, we've funded sensor-equipped drip irrigation systems and energy-efficient pumps to reduce water waste. These efforts have included:

- Modernized wells with a pump and timer system featuring four sensors, which enables night irrigation and humidity monitoring, informing irrigation decisions, lowering energy costs, preserving water, and improving water absorption
- Replacement of under-foliage sprinklers with a tree drip system of fine misting butterfly sprinklers, which cover a larger area, promote even water distribution, reduce overwatering, and reduce water pressure requirements
- Improved sprinkler-to-tree ratio, with one sprinkler for each tree, rather than one for six trees as before, overall reducing water waste and producing healthier fruit

3 Supporting Community Development

In partnership with dōTERRA Healing Hands[®], our Cō-Impact Sourcing[®] initiatives facilitate community development through projects that enhance health and well-being, including infrastructure improvements, access to clean water, medical care, and programs that uplift individuals and families in sourcing areas.

In 2024, more than **40 initiatives in 14 sourcing countries** were funded by dōTERRA Healing Hands. These efforts delivered significant progress through projects such as:



Empowering Children in Eswatini

In Bulembu, Eswatini—a thriving community and source of Eucalyptus essential oil—the dōTERRA Healing Hands Foundation supported critical community needs for:

- 1,400 people by providing medical supplies through a local clinic
- 200 children who received school uniforms
- 300 children who benefited from transportation support, including 25 children who received a new special needs curriculum
- Orphaned and vulnerable youth by funding a bus to provide transportation for home visits and community activities.



3 Supporting Community Development

Providing Clean Water in Nepal

In Sindhupalchok, Nepal—where Wintergreen essential oil is sourced—the dōTERRA Healing Hands Foundation addressed water scarcity by funding new piping systems, providing:

- Over 1,000 families with access to clean water
- Two schools with updated water systems to ensure reliable water access
- Freed up time for women and children to focus on education and economic activities by reducing the burden of collecting water

Expanding Daycare Facilities in Canada

In Chapais, Quebec—where Black Spruce essential oil is sourced—the dōTERRA Healing Hands Foundation Canada funded projects to enhance local community services to benefit:

- 1,610 individuals, including parents and children under 5, by supporting a nonprofit daycare kitchen that serves meals
- Local families in Chapais by creating a dedicated space for parenting classes and meal preparation workshops

In 2024, the **dōTERRA Healing Hands Foundation® responded in times of crisis with initiatives like 72-Hour Emergency Relief Hygiene Kits,** providing essential supplies and support to help individuals and communities recover and rebuild.

Support Following Hurricanes Helene and Milton

Working with 258 Wellness Advocates and their teams, 27,800 dōTERRA 72-Hour Emergency Relief Hygiene Kits were distributed to victims of the hurricanes, benefiting thousands in impacted areas.

One kit recipient in North Carolina shared, "After several days, some neighbors from South Carolina were able to bring us some water and a few supplies. And in our bag was a dōTERRA 72-Hour Emergency Relief Hygiene kit for each of us—we saw some light in our darkness."

dōTERRA Diamond Tatiana Grant was among the Wellness Advocates who helped with kit distribution in Florida. She shared, "My family and I distributed Ithe kits] this morning, and the response from our community was incredibly appreciative. We delivered the kits to [a local] disaster relief site. They were thrilled and eager to see everything included in the kits. They mentioned that the supplies would be invaluable as they continue to support those who have lost their homes here in Sarasota."



Help in the Wake of Severe Tropical Storm Kristine

On October 23, 2024, Severe Tropical Storm Kristine made landfall in the Philippines, causing widespread flooding that affected millions of people and caused hundreds of causalities.

Working with Angat Buhay, dōTERRA Philippines was able to distribute 750 72-Hour Emergency Relief Hygiene Kits to individuals in need.

Many doTERRA Wellness Advocates are not only entrepreneurs and business owners but also passionate philanthropists. The Match Program is designed to help them turn their passion into action by doubling their fundraising efforts for meaningful humanitarian projects.

Through the Match Program, doTERRA Healing Hands provides matching grants to Wellness Advocates who have reached the rank of Elite or higher, allowing them to collaborate with qualifying nonprofit organizations to make a lasting difference. Hundreds of Match projects are funded each year, impacting thousands of women, children, and communities worldwide.

Technology has the power to transform lives, yet it remains out of reach for many underserved communities. Through the Match Program, Wellness Advocate Hiroko Nagatomo helped bridge this gap for a community in Ghana.

Hiroko Nagatomo partnered with African ICT Right to establish a computer lab for an elementary school in Ghana. Funded through the Match Program, this project benefited over 1,425 individuals. The new lab provides students with access to digital learning tools, supports adult education, and strengthens the community's digital economy.

When Jenni and Mike lost their daughter, Raquel, to cancer, they turned their grief into a mission—empowering children through education in her honor. Partnering with Living Hope Educational Enterprises **through the Match Program, they provided much-needed school supplies and technology to the School of Living Hope in Pakistan.**

Their efforts benefited 200 students and their families, reaching an estimated 500 people. Many of these students previously lacked access to technology at home. With the newly equipped school, they now have the opportunity to develop essential digital skills that will shape their futures.

Reforestation in Action

Kealakekua Mountain Reserve in Hawai'i Native Reforestation Projects

In Hawai'i, deforestation and overgrazing have severely impacted native ecosystems, threatening biodiversity and traditional cultural practices. Since 2018, dōTERRA has been working to restore these lands at the Kealakekua Mountain Reserve by reintroducing native trees and supporting sustainable land stewardship.

This work has helped bring native bird species back to the region, restore traditional Hawaiian flora, and create new opportunities for sustainable agriculture and conservation. For the local community, these efforts have meant not only the revival of critical ecosystems but also the preservation of cultural connections to the land ensuring that future generations can continue to thrive in harmony with nature.
