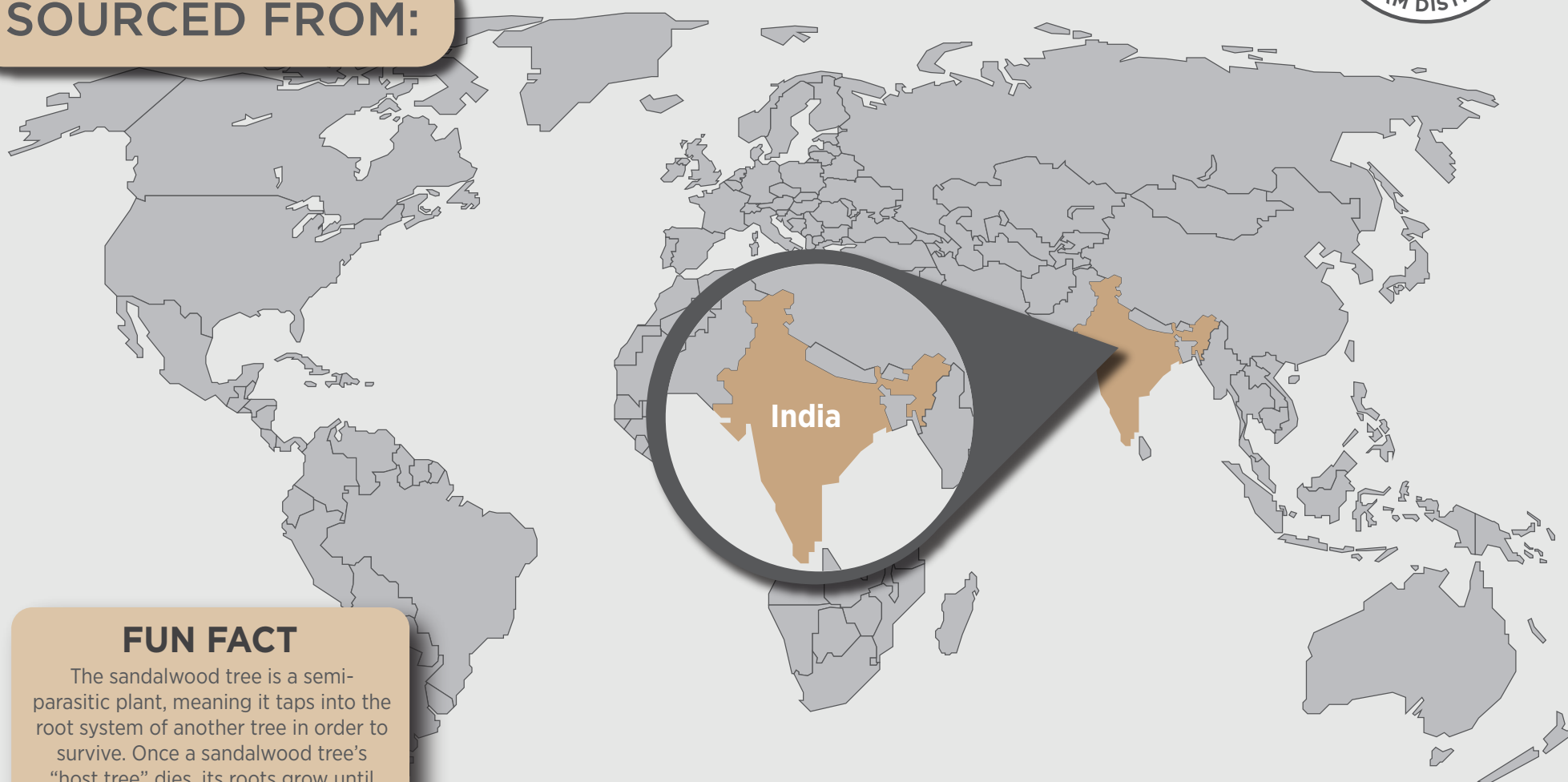


Sandalwood A T I N

The sandalwood tree is a semi-parasitic plant, meaning it taps into the root system of another tree in order to survive. Once a sandalwood tree's "host tree" dies, its roots grow until it finds a new host.
