Incentive Trip Project Details

We'll try to accommodate your project preference, but some projects only require a handful of people and will fill up fast. Don't worry, there's work for everybody!

Project signups will be at Registration on Monday, February 3. You're also welcome to visit the Hospitality Desk to adjust your group or project.

Mixing and Applying Stucco

- Most of you will be doing this very important project that was carried over from the last time we were here in 2019. Let's finish what we started!
- · You'll mix stucco with bare feet (it's fun!).
- You'll deliver the stucco via wheelbarrow to various parts of the property and apply it. (Some in direct sunlight, so stay hydrated.)

Structure Repair & Improvement Throughout the Property

- · You'll lift and install a wire fence (requires using pliers).
- · You'll sand and paint rusty metal posts.
- You'll install plastic roofing (requires using a drill and ladder).

Painting (Just White Paint)

- You'll freshen curbs with white paint (requires bending over or sitting on the ground).
- You'll paint designated walls inside the facility (one person on a ladder with another supporting).
- Certain designated outdoor walls need to be touched up (some of you will be on a ladder and others supporting the ladder)

Painting & Waterproofing Wall for Orchid Garden

 The wall that will feature the orchid garden needs to be painted and waterproofed (1 person will be on a ladder with 1 ladder supporter)

Painting Murals

- Certain designated outdoor walls need colorful murals painted on them (some of you will be on a ladder and others supporting the ladder)
- Remove current drawing on some of the windows and painting new ones.

Cleaning Solar Panels & Metal Post Repair

- You'll wash the panels with water, soap, and sponges, rinsing afterward with a pressure washer.
- You'll sand and waterproof the metal posts that hold up the panels.

Outdoor Compost Toilet

 You'll build walls, roof & a seat (use of ladder with supporter and use of drill for some volunteers)

Building a Multisensory Garden

- · You'll spread soil.
- You'll lay bricks for a path perimeter.
- You'll install a wire fence.
- You'll make and hang textured curtains (one person on a ladder with another supporting).
- You'll install a simple sprinkler system.
- You'll install different materials for feet/pathway
- · You'll set up speakers.

Insulating Outdoor Gazebo

- You'll cut foam panels to size and install them (requires using a knife and measuring tape).
- You'll install foam panels (one person on a ladder with another supporting).

Planting

- You'll either plant seeds or small plants throughout the property or help prepare them for planting.
- · You might work on the indoor garden as well!

Preparing Rebar and Mixing, Transporting, and Laying Cement

- · You'll prepare rebar for cement laying.
- You'll use a shovel to mix cement.
- You'll transport cement to various work sites around the property.

Cleaning Glass & Tile around the Therapy Pool

 You'll wash the glass walls surrounding the therapy pool. Bring your swimsuit if you want to help here. Know that you might not need it if you're cleaning the outside part—just the inside.

Giving Massages & Playing with Children

- You'll provide massages to the hardworking staff.
 Please sign up for this job if you're a licensed massage therapist! Essential oils will be provided.
- If you want to take it easy & play with the kids, this is for you!

Installing Anticollision Stickers

 You'll apply anticollision stickers on over 70 windows to protect birds from hitting them (one person on a ladder with another supporting).
