

Planting Seeds

Heather puts a huge emphasis on long-term vison. "Everything we do plays a role in future success—not just short-term success. Sometimes we even have to sacrifice a short-term win if it means a bigger win down the road."

This is what doTERRA is all about for Heather—building for the future. "This consistent, future-focused mentality helps my leaders push through momentary struggles. I assure them that because they choose to show up time and time again, seeds are being planted that they'll harvest one day!"



Take Action

When Heather first encountered doTERRA® essential oils over 11 years ago, she knew they had to be part of her home. Immediately, she was a loyal customer. She placed a loyalty order every month and generously shared her essential oils with those who were open—simply because she wanted to help people.

But Heather didn't start building a dōTERRA business right away. In fact, she actually made a thriving business with a different network marketing company!

"Fast-forward to summer 2019," Heather says, "I was nine years into my business. I made a six-figure income and had a team who were family to me. I planned to be with this company forever, but God opened my eyes and

told me in my heart that it was time to let go, leave my company, and move to doTERRA."

Heather continues, "I couldn't have been more shocked. At the height of my career, I'd need to give up my income, team family, position—things I loved that were part of me. I couldn't sell what I'd built. My heart could hardly handle it. In fact, it took me six months of processing and gathering the courage to accept God's direction and take action."

In December 2019, Heather took her big step into the unknown and started building a dōTERRA business. After almost a decade as a dōTERRA customer and having already built a successful networking marketing business before, Heather hoped—and even expected—her progress to be fast.

"We're grateful on a regular basis that we're where we are with doTERRA, working with the people we do. Our impact is so much deeper and extensive by being part of this company. The personal freedom we'd been seeking is becoming a reality."—Heather Andersen

However, things didn't go as expected. She explains, "We had a study going with 300 people right when the US shut down in March 2020. We thought we'd have loads of enrollments and tons of rank advancements. But when things shut down, many people lost their jobs and were afraid. They didn't know if they'd have a paycheck, so they closed their wallets. Also, my skills were in home classes and parties, and people weren't doing that at all. We had to pivot to virtual networking, trying to figure out how to connect with everyone and provide quality essential oil experiences. It was tough, but we just kept going. We tried different things. We didn't quit. I worked tirelessly through the pandemic, plowing forward (and through our savings). There was no other option but for this business to work."

Looking back, Heather says, "My expectations and timelines frustrated me, and I felt like things just weren't working. Something I realize now is though your rank may not reflect forward movement, as long as you're consistently working on your business, there's real growth happening. I had no movement for a long time and then double rank advanced. The growth was there. I just wasn't seeing it."

All things considered, the growth of Heather's business has been incredibly fast. She achieved Diamond in 18 months and qualified for both US Founders Club 2.0 and Blue Diamond only a year after that. Regardless of how fast you feel your business is or isn't progressing, Heather offers this reminder: "You're doing better than you think you are. You're moving forward, even if you can't see it right now."

Attempt Anyway

In 2020, Elyse decided to go for Diamond. It was early in the pandemic and seemed like a bold move, but she also felt it was time. She discussed it with her upline, and together they made a four-month strategy that would allow her to reach Diamond for the first time in November 2020. She announced it to her team, rallying everyone for the journey they'd all be taking.

And then, one by one, her leaders quit or stepped back. Nine people—almost her entire team—left. Elyse says, "For about a month, I cried and felt hopeless." But when she asked her upline if she should even attempt her lofty goal anymore, Elyse received a firm yes. "My upline told me she'd let me wallow long enough and of course I should still go for Diamond. She asked, 'What's the alternative? You're just not going to try? You're a strong leader. You're building your business anyway. It doesn't make any sense not to go for it."

Somehow, Elyse made it happen. In November 2020, she hit Diamond for the first time. "I learned a lot throughout that process," she reflects. "I learned I can't control what my team or leaders do. I can only control how I handle it. I learned not everyone is going to be with me long-term, but everyone is a special part of my journey, and I can respect, love, and support where each person is. I learned about my own mindset and grit. Now, when I have team members who are feeling down, or when they have someone quit, I have that story. It helps my team see things will be okay. People quitting is part of your journey, and you can still hit your goals."


When Elyse has a leader who's struggling, she follows a checklist to identify where support is needed:

- Are they pursuing personal development? Everyone
 has struggles and challenges, so pursuing personal
 development and listening to other successful people
 can take them places they can't get to alone. "When
 I'm stuck, I take the time to really dig into my mindset
 and actions and do some personal development."
- How many people are they connecting with each week? Are they actually spending time doing the PIPES activities? If not, get their focus back on PIPES.
- Are they doing weekly mentor calls or check-ins with their upline? Are they attending team calls to feel connected? Entrepreneurship can be lonely. It's important that they stay connected, whether through team calls, weekly mentor calls, corporate events, and so on.
- Are they talking about the business opportunity with people?
- What's their Why? What are their personal goals with doTERRA?

Elyse says, "Usually, diving deep into a few of these prompts helps me and the leader see where there might be gaps—especially when it comes to their Why and their goals, which can get lost in the process. I feel like part my job is to help them remember why they're building a dōTERRA business in the first place and bring them back to their original goals during the inevitable hard times."

Advice from Elyse

"I wish I could go back and tell myself to talk about the business more. I was so focused on the products and helping people with their health that I just didn't focus on finding business builders and spreading the joy of sharing essential oils. I realized I could not only progress faster in this business with more leaders and sharers but also have a greater impact, helping 10 times more people. That was a huge shift for me."







Tell us about your journey to Presidential Diamond.

What's the biggest lesson you've learned? What've been
the biggest hurdles you've overcome?

It was a seven-year journey to Presidential Diamond. We had lots of ups and downs. We spent our first 10 months at Elite (despite working extremely hard on our business). Then we plateaued at Platinum for four years, but we kept moving forward with faith and a clear vision of what we wanted to create.

The biggest lesson we've learned is the only true limitations are the ones we put on ourselves. With a combination of hard work, ingenuity, and persistence, anything is possible. It's never your circumstances that determine your results.

Our biggest hurdles—both emotionally and for our business—cropped up when people we believed in decided to step away. It required us to detach ourselves from any one person's commitment and always actively look for our next Diamond leader! We had to keep our minds right and our feet moving.

What advice would you give to someone who's trying to reach Presidential Diamond?

Recognize that all your results come from your way of thinking and start retraining your brain. All our biggest breakthroughs and advancements in our business came from consistent effort paired with important mindset shifts. Mindset coaching played such a pivotal role for our success that Seantay became a certified coach to help others experience similar breakthroughs.

How do you and your spouse work together in your business? What advice do you have for other couples working together?

Our dynamics have shifted a lot over the years. We both committed early on to become proficient in all building roles, which has allowed us to do what we call "hacky-sacking," supporting each other. We both teach classes, recruit, train, and mentor.

We've never achieved (or needed) perfect balance to be happy or feel loved. We just do our best, and sometimes we fail. We feel like this business model overall allows for more balance in family and career, and it teaches our kids good principles like service.

Some people don't want to reach Presidential Diamond because of how much work and stress it seems to entail. What are the benefits of this rank? Why should someone want to reach it?

If you're stressed, you'll likely be stressed with or without going for Presidential Diamond. It isn't actually the effort or workload that causes stress, but rather your mindset.

Reaching Presidential Diamond creates so much freedom, and the journey to get there will shape you into a better version of yourself. It's allowed us to travel around the world as a family, create unforgettable memories, and learn valuable lessons together.

What motivates you to continue building your busines

The emotional revenue of building a dōTERRA business is truly amazing. We love helping new people experience a level of freedom. We also have big financial goals and dream of a potential recurring income.



Before deciding to create a dōTERRA® business, Tatiana struggled to maintain a work-life balance in her corporate position. "It was tiring. My balance was completely compromised." One of the great appeals of a dōTERRA business for her is the potential for balance and flexibility. "dōTERRA actually allows me to be more flexible in life," she says. "I can work and care for my family!"

Tatiana achieves flexibility in her business with clear priorities. "I tend to prioritize only what will create the most impact and move other, smaller priorities to the side or completely delete them." She recommends anyone building a business—or just seeking greater work-life balance—try this approach and master it: "Once a month, write down the three most important goals you want to accomplish. Every morning, write down the five most important things you need to do that day, aligning them with your monthly goals. If they don't align or aren't critical, just delete them. You can even do this with yearly goals!"

One of Tatiana's top priorities has been attending dōTERRA events with members of her team. "I ensure my builders fully experience dōTERRA by dōTERRA." This focused effort has paid off immensely for her, keeping her vision and dream alive. "When I was struggling myself, I accidentally won a trip to Mexicot (the last spot!), and I brought a builder who was also about to quit. It was life-changing. After returning, we both grew quickly. We committed to participating in as many dōTERRA events as possible and have tried to win—and motivate the team to win—spots on Incentive Trips." She continues, "There's something magical about dōTERRA events. If you truly want to grow, I suggest going to the events."

Another important priority Tatiana advocates for is self-reflection and development. She feels that, too often in this business, people can push success onto those around them. "We fantasize, thinking, Wow, I finally found the right people, so I'm putting all my hopes and dreams on them." Instead, Tatiana always looks at herself, holding herself accountable for her dreams and business. "I've learned it's not another person who makes you successful. It's you," she says. "I want to be a rock-solid network marketing professional, and I measure my success by my personal growth. If something fails, it means I failed somewhere along the way."

her team and herself has led Tatiana to where she is today. She advises others walking the same path to wisely prioritize and invest in themselves. "Be the greater person. Choose to reshape yourself to where you want to live. Success is something you attract by the person you become. So invest in yourself, and everything will change."

Don't Count Anyone Out

When they first signed up with dōTERRA, Suzanne and Derek weren't what some might have assumed to be ideal builders. "We'd just moved thousands of miles across the country from South Jordan, Utah, to Little Rock, Arkansas, for Derek to go to law school," Suzanne recalls. "I was a stay-at-home homeschool mom. We had eight children, at the time ranging from age two to in college. And we were on a super tight budget." So tight that they couldn't even afford the essential oils they loved, which they were introduced to by Wellness Advocate Gale Sangren.

However, Gale informed them they could earn free products by sharing with others. "We had few friends as we were in a new place, knew next to nothing about the industry, and didn't know if we could teach a good class," Suzanne says. They weren't confident they could make it work as a business or even get the free oils.

But with the faith Gale showed in them and their own growing desire to live their ideal life, Suzanne and Derek decided to go all in together. "We taught as many classes as we could as fast as possible, sharing about these wonderful products so that we could have the money we needed for our loyalty order. But we were surprised by the success we found." Together, the couple elevated their business to heights they hadn't even imagined. "We built this doTERRA business

together as a couple from the beginning. Ever since, we both try to attend all the classes we can. And we love to teach classes together or to take turns with who teaches. We've done Diamond Club three times."

Their experiences building a dōTERRA business taught Suzanne and Derek two useful lessons. "People can reach their dōTERRA goals as long as they stay committed and maintain forward movement each day." It wasn't easy to start where they did, but by combining their talents, persevering, and believing strongly in the opportunity in front of them, Suzanne and Derek made it a success, realizing this: "Don't count anyone out. Those with low income, busy schedules, or any other seeming disadvantages—no one. Absolutely everyone needs these oils."

What Suzanne and Derek love most about their dōTERRA business is that it's entirely theirs. "We can work it into our day as we see fit," says Suzanne. L'aventure


