By sourcing copaiba oleoresin for essential oil in the state of Amazonas, we support the livelihoods of more than 3,000 harvesters.

Copaiba trees grow in tropical South America, especially along the Amazon River of Brazil. The Amazon Basin experiences about 80–85% humidity year-round, with an average of 90 inches of rain per year. Because of its position on the equator, the Amazon Rainforest experiences 12 hours of sunlight every day of the year. These conditions are exceptional for plant growth, and copaiba trees thrive in this unique climate. A copaiba tree can live up to 400 years and grow more than 100 feet tall.

By sourcing copaiba oleoresin for essential oil in the state of Amazonas, we support the livelihoods of more than 3,000 harvesters. Through dōTERRA, these harvesters receive fair, on-time payments.

During the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, our Copaiba essential oil supplier, Beraca, and their NGO, Instituto Beraca, partnered with dōTERRA Healing Hands to bring immediate relief to harvesting families through basic provisions packages of food and hygiene supplies.

The packages contained enough supplies to last a family two to four weeks and were delivered to 450 families—about 2,250 people total—in seven harvesting areas. dōTERRA Healing Hands also partnered with Instituto Beraca and two other organizations to support two local hospitals and 24 healthcare units throughout the greater region.

Dental Clinic

In 2019, dōTERRA Healing Hands provided a dental camp in harvesting regions of the Amazon Rainforest. Three dentists traveled by boat to set up temporary clinics that provided extractions, fillings, toothbrushes, toothpaste, and education on proper dental hygiene to more than 150 people in 11 communities.
