Tulsi, also known as Holy Basil, is an aromatic shrub from the basil family. It is extracted from the flower of the plant, as the blossoms are too delicate for steam distillation.

- The plant is thought to have originated in northern central India.
- It's wild harvested early in the year, usually in January and February.
- Within Ayurveda, Tulsi is known as the incomparable one and the queen of herbs.
- The plant grows in direct sunlight.
