


# **Quarter Introduction**

# Malama Maui

From stage at Becoming | dōTERRA Convention 2023, Vice President, Philanthropy and Community Impact Missy Larsen shared about our efforts to help ease the devastation of the fires that impacted Maui in August. When the fires overtook Lahaina, Wellness Advocates Eliza Yoshida and Maile Mai'i jumped into action, working together to mobilize their teams and provide aid.

In a matter of days, more than 50 Wellness Advocates in Hawaii had distributed more than 8,300 emergency relief hygiene kits to local families, shelters, and emergency centers. Additional efforts involved Wellness Advocates working with Hawaiian government leaders and nonprofit organizations.

Other members of the dōTERRA family rallied, donating to a fundraiser hosted by the dōTERRA Healing Hands Foundation®. Every dollar raised was matched up to \$100,000 thanks to the generosity of a dōTERRA® Executive Founder. With approximately \$200,000 raised, dōTERRA Healing Hands is working with on-the-ground partners to identify needs. So far, we have:

- Donated to ALL PONO. This donation provided baseball, softball, hula, and other sports equipment to support a community focus on the children in Maui impacted by the fires.
- Donated to the Hana Arts Center. In the wake of the fires, the Hana Arts Center hosted a fundraiser for the Common Ground Collective, which provides meals to those displaced by the Lahaina fires. Through this donation to the fundraiser, 2,223 meals were provided.
- Donated to Nohona Health. This donation provided respiratory and other medical supplies to support fire victims in Maui.

We will continue to follow recovery efforts in Maui, offering support and help.

During Q3, dōTERRA Mexico used the AromaTouch® Hand Technique to empower people at Casa Hogar Marillac, AC to be healthy, safe, and self-reliant. Located in Mexico City, Casa Hogar Marillac, AC is a senior center that provides a home and comprehensive care for elderly individuals. During the service project, 24 volunteers consisting of Wellness Advocates and dōTERRA employees gave the AromaTouch Hand Technique to 100 individuals. Through this opportunity, volunteers not only provided the AromaTouch Hand Technique, but were good company for the seniors present. The care center was also in need of hygiene items, so dōTERRA Mexico donated hygiene kits that included shampoo, toothpaste, and Deep Blue®.

# Twins Safely Delivered Thanks to the Sanaag Specialty Hospital

Fadumo Maxamed Maxamoud learned she was pregnant with twins while attending an antenatal clinic at the Sanaag Specialty Hospital (SSH). On July 7th, Fadumo went into labor and was quickly driven to SSH. She delivered her first baby, a boy weighing 1.7 kg, without incident. However, the second twin would not come out. After an examination, the doctor recommended a C-section for delivering the

other twin. Faduma was quickly wheeled into the operating theatre and a few minutes later the second baby boy was delivered weighing 2.2 kg. The babies were nursed in the NICU for several days before going home with their family. This happy ending was made possible by SSH and its incredible staff. Because of their hard work, Fadumo and her babies are alive and doing well.
