During Q2, donations to the doTERRA Healing Hands Foundation® went to projects like expanding a daycare kitchen through the nonprofit organization Le Petit Train Inc. Located in the Black Spruce sourcing area in Chapais, Quebec, Canada, this nonprofit kitchen teaches new parents how to feed, bathe, and care for their children. It also provides healthy food to those in need.

While Le Petit Train Inc. benefits its community, it has a tight budget, requiring donations from outside partners to pursue additional projects beyond its day-to-day efforts. Thanks to funds donated by the doTERRA Healing Hands Foundation, Le Petit Train Inc. will be able to expand its kitchen, enabling the nonprofit to feed and serve even more community members. Many young

families in Chapais rely on this small, helpful kitchen, and now over 1,600 people will be positively impacted by this update.

Promoting Inclusion in Hong Kong

During Q2, the doTERRA Hong Kong market held two DIY workshops for the Hong Kong Rehabilitation Power and Integrated Family Service Centre (HKRP). Founded in 1995, the HKRP promotes inclusion for people with disabilities, working to create equal opportunities.

During these workshops, the Hong Kong market educated about essential oils and worked with participants to create hundreds of passive diffusers. Made in special doTERRA Healing Hands® molds with coloring and cement, each handmade diffuser was a one-of-a-kind memento perfect for essential oil lovers. The diffusers were sold at a charity event, generating funds for the HKRP to continue their important work.

Empowering Communities in Ghana through Technology

Technology increases connections and opens doors to countless opportunities. It's something we often take for granted in modern times. In underserved communities, technology isn't always readily available, yet it can be immensely transformative.



Working through the Match Program, Blue Diamond Hiroko Nagatomo raised funds to provide a computer lab for an elementary school in Ghana alongside the nonprofit African ICT Right. The lab will impact over 1,425 people, improving the community's digital economy, development, and self-reliance.

For students and teachers, the lab will expand their access to tools and resources, enabling greater learning and understanding. For the broader community, it'll open doorways through new opportunities like adult education classes outside of school hours.

When asked about the project, Hiroko shared, "Being passionate about providing computer labs to deprived communities is rooted in the belief that technology is a lever for equity and social justice. It represents a commitment to breaking down barriers, empowering individuals, and supporting communities in achieving sustainable growth and development."

Inaugural Celebration at the Chitlang Health Post

In May, Wellness Advocates and the Cō-Impact Sourcing® team joined inaugural celebrations for the Chitlang Health Post in Nepal. Funded in part by the dōTERRA China market, the initial groundbreaking was held in February 2023.

The health post will now serve members of the Wintergreen sourcing community, providing improved access to healthcare and opportunities for hospital crew members to upgrade their skills. It'll impact approximately 1,200 households in the area.

It's impossible to entirely predict the impact of this health post, but we hope the difference it makes for this community lasts for generations!

The Chitlang Health Post will impact approximately **1,200** households.
